**SI**: **John Adams** *Our constitution was made only for a moral & religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.* 

**GA**: Disturbed by what I see in America – equally by our spiritual state.

**ORT/NEED**: How do you interact w/the ungodly? Your lost neighbor? How  $\Theta$ 's people live in the church—to how they live in the world. 1 **Pet 2:9-10** But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His possession, so that you may proclaim the praises of the One who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. Once you were not a people, but now you are  $\Theta$ 's people; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

CXT: 1:5 The reason I left you in Crete was to set right what was left undone &, as I directed you, to appoint elders in every town. Revered Zeus—liar & a womanizer. Immortalized him for his underhanded ways. The Cretans cast themselves in his image—they were liars, self-indulgent, sexually deviant. Governed by ungodly leader (Nero). Known as immoral, carnal, arrogant, greedy, treacherous. Xians were in the moral minority—recipients of both slander/violence. Similar?

- Paganism.
- Post-Xian America—Cultural Xianity.

Reaction? Sadness to anger—Brokenness to apathy. Paul writes to keep them from feeling hostile toward & superior to the unconverted.

**CIT**: Titus was to remind the church that the gospel that saved & transformed them should also impact everyone around them.

**CIS**: The gospel's transforming power calls for you to live a life that is attractive to the lost.

**PNP**:  $\Theta$  reminds us that our transformed lives should impact 2 areas.

## Take care of how you operate in the world.

- vv1b-2 Remember your responsibilities as a *X*ian.
- 1 <u>Remind</u> them those who have experienced grace 2:11 to <sup>1</sup> submit to rulers & authorities, to <sup>2</sup> obey, to <sup>3</sup> be ready for every good work, 2 to <sup>1</sup> slander no one, to <sup>2</sup> avoid fighting not contentious, & to <sup>3</sup> be kind courteous/not pharisaical, always <sup>7</sup> showing gentleness not self-important to all people.

**Eph 6:6** but as slaves of X, doing  $\Theta$ 's will from your heart.

- **v3** Remember when you were lost.
- **3** For we too were once <sup>1</sup>foolish <sup>no knowledge/no sense</sup>, <sup>2</sup>disobedient <sup>defies</sup> authority, <sup>3</sup>deceived <sup>unenlightened by revelation</sup>, <sup>4</sup>enslaved by various passions & pleasures, <sup>5</sup>living in malice <sup>mean-spirited</sup> & <sup>6</sup>envy, <sup>7</sup>hateful, detesting one another.
- **1 Cor 6:11** Some of you used to be like this. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord  $\underline{JX}$  & by the  $\underline{S}$  of our  $\Theta$ .
  - vv4-7 Remember when <u>J</u> saved you.
- **4** But when the <sup>1</sup>kindness <sup>goodness</sup> of  $\Theta$  our Savior & His <sup>2</sup>love <sup>affectionate</sup> concern for mankind appeared, **5** He saved us—not by works of righteousness that we had done, but according to His <sup>3</sup>mercy—through the <sup>4</sup>washing <sup>cleansing</sup> of regeneration <sup>new birth</sup> & <sup>5</sup>renewal <sup>sanctification</sup> by the  $\underline{HS}$ . **6** He poured out His  $\underline{S}$  on us abundantly <sup>richly 6</sup>through  $\underline{JX}$  our Savior **7** <u>so that</u>, having been justified <sup>by imputation</sup> by His <sup>7</sup>grace, we may become heirs w/the hope of eternal life.
- **Ro 2:4** Or do you despise the riches of his kindness, restraint, & patience, not recognizing that  $\Theta$ 's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance?

- **v8** Remember your mission to the unbeliever.
- **8** This saying  $\frac{\log os/gospel}{s}$  is trustworthy. I want you to insist on these things, so that those who have believed  $\Theta$  might be careful to devote themselves to good works. These are good & profitable for everyone sinners outside the church in need of grace

Mt 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works & give glory to your Father in heaven.

Trans: Attractive life before the world – built on sanctified relationships. Take care of how you relate to certain groups.

- v9 Relationships w/false teachers.
- **9** But <u>avoid</u> foolish debates, genealogies, quarrels, & disputes about the law, because they are <u>unprofitable</u> & worthless.
  - **Heretics** avoid.
  - **People error** be to them what you can be, to strengthen what can be.
  - vv10-11 Relationships w/factious people.
- **10** <u>Reject</u> Mt 18:15-17 a divisive person after a first & second warning. **11** For you know that such a person has gone astray warped/perverted & is sinning; he is self-condemned it is his own fault for being obstinate.
  - vv12-13 Relationships w/fellow servants.
- 12 When I send Artemas or Tychicus to you, <u>make every effort</u> to come to me in Nicopolis, because I have decided to spend the winter there. 13 Diligently <u>help</u> Zenas the lawyer & Apollos on their journey, <u>so that</u> they will lack nothing.
  - vv14-15 Relationships w/faithful friends.
- **14** Let our people <u>learn</u> to devote themselves to good works for pressing needs, <u>so that</u> they will not be unfruitful. **15** All those who are w/me send you greetings. <u>Greet</u> those who love us in the faith i.e. the faithful. Grace be w/all of you though addressed to an individual.

**CIS**: The gospel's transforming power calls for you to live a life that is attractive to the lost.

**CEP**: **1**:16 [False teachers] *claim to know*  $\Theta$ , *but they deny him by their works. They are detestable, disobedient,* & *unfit for any good work*.

**1:8** [The pastor is to be] *loving what is good*. **2:7** [He is to] *make* [himself] *an example of good works* w/integrity & dignity in [his] *teaching*.

2:14 [X] gave Himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness & to cleanse for Himself a people for His own possession, eager to do good works. 3:1 Remind [those touched by grace] to submit to rulers & authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work. 3:8 Those who have believed Θ might be careful to devote themselves to good works. These are good & profitable for everyone. 3:14 Let [Θ's] people learn to devote themselves to good works for pressing needs, so that they will not be unfruitful.

**G**: 5 He saved us—not by <u>works</u> of righteousness that we had done, but according to His mercy.
